SPIRITUAL WARFARE: MADE-UP or SCRIPTURAL?

The Apostle Paul commended a Christian community in the City of Berea for several reasons: they were receptive to the Word of God; they investigated the Scriptures for themselves - rather than just taking on-authority Paul’s teachings to them; they guarded and protected Paul from his enemies; and they actively pursued growing in their faith.

We have the responsibility as Christian Disciples of Jesus Christ to be “good Bereans”. Let’s search the Scriptures together to arrive at a conclusion as to whether Spiritual Warfare is some made-up, fringe, novel, and/or sensationalistic preoccupation of certain sects of Christianity or whether it is knowledge, training, perspective, discipline, and execution every disciple of Christ ought to mature in.

The actual text to the Scripture citations below is deliberately not included here. **RESCUE** wants you to put in the effort to look these Scriptures up. To read them in context. To engage with your Bible and all your study resources and supplements. As you’ll see in your study, the Word of God is the Sword of the Spirit; here’s a little weapons-training opportunity 😊.
